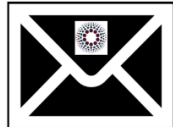

Applications are now open for the **Municipal Electric Awards**.

It's the second year for the awards, which are presented by **Local Governments for Sustainability (ICLEI)** and **Electric Mobility Canada**, a national membership-based non-for-profit organization dedicated to the advancement of e-mobility.

The awards recognize the efforts of Canadian municipalities committed to low-carbon economy and electric mobility. This year's awards will honour three municipalities that have made a tangible commitment to electromobility – one in each of the following categories:

- Municipalities with a population over 200,000
- Municipalities with a population between 50,000-200,000 people
- Municipalities with a population less than 50,000

For 2020, municipalities will be judged based on their pro-EV initiatives undertaken to date, including but not limited to: the conversion of the municipal fleet to electric vehicles, the installation of charging infrastructure; and any programs, policies and regulations implemented to facilitate electromobility by residents and businesses.

Last year, the municipal winners included Plessisville, and Montreal, Quebec; and Kingston, Ontario.

The deadline to apply is March 15, 2020.

The 2020 Municipal Electric Awards will be announced in April during EMC's annual conference in Mississauga.
