

Evaluation Criteria

Climate Change Leaders Award 2023



Projects will be rated based on the cumulative score from the categories listed below.

Overall impression (sections 3.a to 3.f) **25%**

- The extent to which the project represents the initial goals set prior to the implementation of the project. This includes how well a project targets areas of concern highlighted in any planning documents (such as the municipality's MCCAP).

Innovation (sections 4.a) **20%**

- The extent to which the implementation of this project addressed climate change adaptation and/or mitigation. This can be demonstrated through quantitative or qualitative evidence.

Outcomes (sections 4.b) **35%**

- Social, economic, and environmental benefits that the project has had through climate change mitigation and/or adaptation. For example, social benefits might entail the creation of cleaner, safer water. Economic might be the savings generated from the project and payback period while environmental benefits might be evident through reductions in harmful GHG emissions.

Next steps (sections 4.c) **20%**

- In the effort to support continuous action, state the projects that will stem from the completion of this project.
